

Internship and Research on European Affairs in Barcelona, Spain

Available Summer 2019



The University of Miami **European Union “Jean Monnet” Chair** is offering an innovative program combining an **internship** training and **individualized research** supervision. Available to all **undergraduate and graduate** students at the University of Miami, it is part of a grant awarded by the European Union. A **certificate of expertise** will be issued for successful trainees. This experience is highly valued when applying for internships at EU sites or other private and government employment.

To receive internship **credit**, candidates **must register** in one of the Summer 2019 UM European Union courses **INS 510, INS 594, INS 605 or INS 656**. In addition to following the course, trainees will be placed (depending on personal inclinations and background qualifications) in a selective government, private non-profit agency or business in Barcelona for a few hours of practical training.

It is expected that the background of the trainee will match the needs and expectations of the governments (the City of Barcelona, the government of Catalonia and the branches of the Spanish government) and/or the private businesses (international trade and transportation, tourism, and media, among others). In either case, students will experience in a practical way the benefits of belonging to the European Union.

The **internship training** includes drafting a short report resulting in a mini-paper, including data collecting, documents development, social media, briefings and lecture reporting, as they are usually required in EU-related internships.
